

## MATTE PAINT MAINTENANCE GUIDE

---

### SUMMARY:

The best care for a matte painted sculpture is to treat it like a luxury cars. Cleaning every 1-3 months with the proper products is best.

---

### MATERIALS:

- 5 gallon bucket
- Soft medium size sponges
- Microfiber clothes (enough to dry the entire sculpture)
- Dr. Beasley's Matte Body Wash
- Dr. Beasley's Matter Paint Sealer
- Dr. Beasley's Matte Final Finish
- Dr. Beasley's Paint Cleanser
